Higley Groves residents whose homes need painting have until the end of 2017 to repaint.


If not complete by 2017 you may be subject to fines.

- 5. Submit your Pre-Approved Paint Request Form Online!


Please note that all painting projects must be submitted to the ARC Committee prior to painting. The requests are still subject to approval.
