Home Painting

In 2019 inspections were completed for homes that appeared to need to be repainted and they were told they would have one year to repaint. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic the board has decided to extend that deadline to the end of 2021.

Courtesy notices may still be given reminding homeowners to paint, but everyone has until the end of 2021 to complete their project.

An architectural change request must be submitted in order to paint your home. Higley Groves does have a list of paint schemes

that qualify for next day approval if the scheme is used exactly as presented.

Front Yard Guidelines

Higley Groves abides by the design guidelines in regards to requirements for plant material and landscaping in the front yard of homes. These guidelines can be found online at http://higleyhoa.com/documents.html.

As a friendly reminder, we are required to have *at least* four (4) five-gallon shrubs and three (3) one-gallon ground covers. Turf must cover at least 50% of the non-driveway area of the front yard and be kept green.

Homeowners will be given until the end of 2021 to come into compliance, then violations will be given.

NO ATVs, UTVs, or motorized vehicles in Common Areas!

Please remember to treat our common areas with respect as they are for the use of all our community members. As a reminder the basketball/pickleball court should only be used to play basketball/pickleball. Skateboarding or any wheeled sport is not allowed on the basketball court.
